



GUIDELINES FOR MAKING A BEQUEST TO NATIVE ANIMAL RESCUE



Writing a will is often a time of reflection on what is important to us and an opportunity to leave a lasting legacy. For this reason, many people have chosen to leave varying contributions to Native Animal Rescue, helping both Western Australia Native local wildlife and the community. These contributions have helped build our hospital, our enclosures and our aviaries. They provide direct provision of care to our patients with food, shelter and medical care. They assist in the running of our Education Centre, which supports local schools and other education programs.

By thinking of these things now it can provide the opportunity to safeguard what is important to you and how you want your assets to be managed.

We recommend you should seek legal advice; to make this process easier. Native Animal Rescue have provided some wording to assist your legal advisor.

We recommend the following wording for your legal adviser's consideration:
